Discipline Training

F.4 students were chosen to attend a camp organized by the Fire Services Department. Adventure Based Training was also conducted for them in our school campus with coaches recruited from Navigator Limited. F.1 and F.2 students were given footdrill trainings in school.

Positive changes were shown among the participants. It is planned that footdrills will continue to be launched for F.1 to F.2 students while Adventure Based Training will be conducted for F.3 and F.4 students in 2005-06.

Remedial Teaching for F.1, F.2, F.4 and F.5

Programmes were conducted for respective levels in summer vacation, Easter holiday and Saturdays. Part-time teachers were recruited and coordinated by teachers in English, Chinese and Mathematics panels. Progress for students has been gradual and similar remedial programmes will be launched in 2005-06. Yet control will be tightened up with pre-tests and post-tests.

Leadership Training

Leadership Training Programmes with external coaches were organized for F.6 students in summer vacation and the first semester. The feedback from students is encouraging and the programme will continue in 2005-06.

Invitational Education Programme

Funds were allocated to class teachers for class based activities such as birthday parties, class based award scheme and intra-class competitions. There were also functions for teaching staff to cultivate harmonious relationship and better sense of belonging. All staff involved considered the activities worthwhile.
