Discipline Training

The Navigator Training Centre is invited to organize adventure-based training programmes for students at all levels. The learning motivation, class cohesiveness and sense of belonging among students are deeply enhanced. Most students regarded this activity as memorable experience. Most teachers considered this function as worthwhile with proper follow up work done by class teachers concerned.

Footdrill training has been offered to F1 to F3 students. Positive changes were shown among the participants. It is expected that such trainings will continue to be launched for students at different levels.

Leadership Training

Leadership Training Programmes with external coaches were organized for prefects and student leaders. Content related to assertiveness and communication skills is regarded as beneficial to students' personal and social development. The feedback from students is encouraging. Similar programmes will be held in the coming school year.

Remedial Training for English and Bridging Programmes for Mathematics and English

Remedial programmes for English, Chinese and Mathematics are held throughout the year. The programmes help consolidate the foundations of core subjects among low achievers.

Enhancement programmes for language subjects are held, aiming at enhancing presentation skills, interactive communication skills and creative writing skills among high achievers. The programmes have been conducted by external NET teachers. Feedback from participants shows that the programmes help elevate their language standards and self-confidence.

Bridging programmes for Chinese and English are held for new F.1 students during summer. Such preparatory courses better prepare new F.1 students to adapt to our language environment, in which Chinese is taught in Putonghua and other subjects taught in English.

Teaching Assistant for Information Technology Section

The Teaching Assistant recruited has provided support and assistance in Computer Literacy lessons at junior levels. She also helps train students for external I.T. competitions, operate school WebSAMS system, design school promotion publications and peers assessment system.

Discipline Teacher

The discipline teacher assists the school to maintain orderly and decent school ethos and environment. He helps deal with late comers, supervise students in suspension class and handle thorny discipline cases. Workload of discipline teachers has been relieved. Improvement in students' punctuality and behaviour is obvious.

Additional Social Worker

The social worker helps work out life education curriculum for all levels and coordinate lessons preparations. She also plans and collaborates with class teachers, subject teachers and guidance team members for school-wide guidance programmes for better sense of belonging. Intervention work for individual cases is timely and professional. Workload of class teachers has been relieved and the feedback is positive.
